Bible Schools In March

Many children who accept Christ hear the Gospel for the first time in Bible school. In Mark 16:15, Jesus commanded us to "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." This mandate is still in effect today. Every year, there is a new group of Haitian children who need to hear the Gospel and accept Jesus Christ.

In March, the team held Bible school at two of our schools, Delmas and Beudet. Last year, the Delmas school burned in a fire.



Through the help of faithful supporters, we were able to rebuild the school and add a new rubber roof which made the classrooms cooler and more comfortable.

For five full days, the team worked with more than 300 children with only a quick lunch in between. They presented Bible stories and Gospel lessons. The children made crafts that emphasized the truths of the Scriptures they were learning. At

the end of the week, the children were presented with the Gospel and invited to pray to receive Jesus as their personal Savior. Fifteen children raised their hands to say that they wanted to be saved.

Most of the March team came from Texas. Two of the team members came from Canada. For most of
