

### **Our Founders' Challenge 2018**



Dear Friends, when Mission To Haiti first began, Ann and I were invited to visit churches at Mosquito Bay in the north of Haiti. The community was remote and the people needed to hear the Gospel. We were there to seek the Lord's will as to where we should serve. We began working with Pastor Jean Claude Thervil in the city of Port de Paix. Today,

Pastor Thervil has a large church and Christian school and a radio station that broadcasts the Gospel to thousands of people in the outlying areas.

Those early days were not easy. Working in Haiti was a struggle. Sometimes we would have to drive through the night to reach villages to hold special meetings. When we arrived, we would stay native homes. We could not carry all of our food, so we would have to rely on the local pastors and the church members to provide meals each day. Many times we got sick and were exhausted because of the hard conditions. But through it all the Lord taught us patience and endurance and prepared us for the work we are doing in Haiti today.

Today, we work with 13 local churches and Christian schools and two vocational schools. We sponsor almost 800 children and impact 4,000 with Christian education and meals at school. Our campus clinic focuses on the health needs of our sponsored children. As the Lord provides, we are expanding our medical efforts even more.

At the heart of our activity in Haiti is our Operating Expenses. The mission campus, offices, vehicles, fuel, equipment, personnel and more keep the ministry moving forward. However, most of the offerings we receive are designated for ministries like Sponsorship.

This year, we need \$50,000 to operate fully on the field. We need your help to raise these funds. Large and small offerings will help us reach our goal for 2018.
