Mountain School Hit Hard By Hurricane

Past the main road that runs south to Ti-Goave and far up into the mountains lie the remnants of the Delatte School building. One wall remains standing with a scrap of tin roofing. The morning is beautiful and school continues in the building. It will suffice for a while, but soon the rains will come and classes will be disrupted.

Hurricane Matthew left a lot of damage in its wake. Gardens were destroyed and trees lost their fruit. Crops will be replanted, but it will take time for the trees





to begin producing fruit again. Hurricanes are common in Haiti but never easy to recover.

In January, Mission To Haiti took a small medical team into this mountain village to help families in need. John Younge (*left*) and the other team members spent time with people who rarely see a doctor. Most of Haiti's population still lives in the backcountry. Pastor Brucely came to this village to evangelize the

people of this remote community. One of the best things we can do to help his efforts is to sponsor children at the school. Christian education is a powerful influence in winning children and families to Christ.

Our goal is to make Christian education available to as many children as possible. We work with pastors and principals to identify children who need help, but it is sponsors who
