The July Mission Team is preparing to build a permanent home for the Bellevue family pictured above. Their house was ruined by the earthquake. The family has been living in a shanty made of scrap materials. Our plan is to build a new home made of concrete blocks and a wood-truss roof.

One of the most pressing needs in Haiti is housing. Most native homes are built from castoff wood and tin. When the tropical rains come, it soaks the house inside and out. A new home for the Bellevues will protect them from the weather as well as rodents and mosquitoes which are the cause of many health problems in Haiti.

It will cost about \$5,000 to complete the house. We have already collected \$3,000. If you can help, your gifts for this new home will be a great blessing to the Bellevue family.
