Sponsorship At Work



Herode is one of our sponsored children. He attends the Delatte School in the south of Haiti. Herode has been suffering from a common affliction that a number of children have in Haiti, a debilitating hernia. In March, Herod was brought in from the rural village where he and his family live. Suzanne worked with the local pastor and the hospital to make the arrangements. Bill and Suzanne visited Herode the next day. He was recovering very well.

The cost of the surgery and follow up will be about \$400. Having the new clinic in place was a great help in arranging Herode's surgery.

When you sponsor a child for \$35 a month, your child receives a Christian education and nutritious meals at school. Also, \$5 of your monthly sponsorship is put into a fund to help pay the expenses of children who need medical help at our clinic or at King's Hospital.

Most of our sponsors have raised their sponsorship from \$30 to \$35 a month. You can provide medical help for your child by adding the \$5 to your monthly sponsorship.
