The simple structure was quaint but hardly adequate for the growing congregation. The small school also met in that building. Pastor Brucely asked Mission To Haiti for help. We began by sponsoring children for school. Today, the Ti-Goave school has grown to more than 700 students.

The meeting place they use now was put together with hand-cut lumber and tin. Often members and visitors must stand outside to participate in the service. The new church building will be well constructed and able to accommodate strong growth.

We appreciated the teams from Sheldon, Iowa and Chicago, Illinois who raised the funds and brought the teams. We will share more about the teams in the March newsletter.
