The New Church At Ti-Goave

While the first January team was getting ready to leave Haiti, the second team was flying into Port au Prince. They were coming to continue where the first team left off. The first team finished pouring the concrete floor for the new church at Ti-Goave. The job of the second team was to lay 2,300 blocks. This would complete the outer walls of the church and prepare the building for the roof.

Last fall, men from Pastor Brucely's church began making the blocks that the team would need for the project. We have a hand-operated machine that makes good solid blocks two at a time. It took several months for the men to make all the blocks by hand.



The second team came from Chicago, Illinois led by Pastor David Ten Clay. David brought block-layers and helpers from his church. The team moved like clock-work.

The team was able to finish the walls, the columns and concrete headers by the end of the trip. After the team left, Pastor Brucely told us that people came from all over the area to admire the building. The congregation is anxious to begin using the new church.

Ten years ago, Sponsorship opened the door for us to begin working at Ti-Goave. We want to thank our sponsors, the teams and everyone who is making this new church possible.

Half Of Haiti's Children Do Not Attend School



Today in Haiti, there are 3,000,000 children under the age of fifteen. It is estimated that half of the children in Haiti do not attend school. Well At Gallette Chambon Gone Dry

The well at Gallette Chambon has gone dry. The water table has dropped which has affected our well and other wells in the community. The church and school depend on this source of water.
