Chris And Bonnie Return From Visiting Churches


For two weeks, Bonnie and I had the privilege of traveling to three states visiting supporters and sharing our ministry with new friends.

The well at the Joineau school has gone dry. This happened at Gallette Chambon recently. The well driller determined that we will need to dig another 50 feet deeper to reach a new source of water. The cost to redig the well by hand will be \$4,500. School will begin soon. Your help is greatly appreciated.
