Prolonged drought in Haiti has led to water shortages, shriveled crops and an increase in food prices. Those people who are most at risk to these conditions are the children and families where we serve. We recently re-dug the well at Gallette Chambon. Now, the well at Joineau has gone dry. Our immediate priority is to meet this pressing need for food and clean water.

*Our goal for the event is to raise \$75,000 through monthly commitments and personal donations.*
