## Founders' Challenge Continues \$43,140

Summers are usually busy in Haiti, and this summer is no exception. In July, we had pastoral interns from Plantation Baptist Church holding a Youth Conference. Some of the Haitian young people who attended were former sponsored children. The focus of this four-day conference was David, The Servant King. These young people have no access to theological training. What they got were indepth, practical studies on how to be a leader with a servant's heart.

This kind of training supports the vision for this ministry: To equip Haitians to change Haiti for Christ!

repairs and getting it back in shape. The painting crew finished the inside of the building. The next step is to install sinks, toilets and cabinets in the bathrooms and replace the metal jalousie windows which are coming apart.

*We need a couple of plumbers and carpenters to do the work. The work will cost \$4,000.*
