We received a call from Pastor Jay Hartzell of Grace Baptist Church. His congregation took an offering to buy food for families who were affected by Hurricane Matthew. He had several men from his church who were willing to come and distribute the food. They would also help evaluate the situation and determine what the long-term needs are.

Two weeks later, Pastor Jay and a team of five other men arrived in Port-au-Prince. The beans, rice and oil were waiting for them. The team, along with our Haitian partners, worked into the evening packing food for about 300 families.

Early the next morning we left for Ti Goave to distribute the food. Children and families were waiting for us to arrive. Pastor Brucely explained that the most pressing need right now is food. Every family has lost a significant portion of their livestock and gardens. They are living in makeshift homes made of sticks and torn tarps.



By providing food for these families, we are giving them the strength to rebuild their lives. Pastor Brucely determined that it will take months to provide food for the surrounding families in his area. We need your continued support for the Haiti Hurricane Relief effort. Thank you for giving!
