The woman seated in the photograph is Elimene Vernelis. Her daughter Navline is standing next to her. For the past couple of years, Elimene suffered from congestive heart failure. For a while, she was able to control her health, but eventually her condition got much worse. We received a generous donation that we used to admit her to a large hospital in Haiti. The medication worked well, but only for a short period of time. Eventually, her body was not strong enough to survive her debilitating condition.

In October, Elimene went home to be with the Lord. Pastor Brucely officiated her ceremony in the church at Ti Goave. He said that she was a faithful church member and wonderful Christian woman. He noted that Elimene never complained, but she was quick to thank the Lord for providing for her.

Elimene's story could be told a dozen times. We are continually approached by pastors, principals, children and families asking for help with their urgent and persistent needs. Mission To Haiti serves to plead the cause of the poor and needy in Haiti. We plead the cause of those who are sick and infirmed. We plead the cause of those who are hungry. And we plead the cause of those who are lost and need a Savior.

Elimene's daughter, Navline is fourteen and is now by herself. Pastor Brucely is looking for a family in his church who will care for her until she becomes an adult. Navline is in the Sponsorship Program, but needs help for her daily needs. It will take \$100 a month to provide for Navline until she is on her own.
