A Present Help In Time Of Need




Haiti is still reeling from the demonstrations that happened in February. Businesses are open and schools are operating, but the Haitian people are still feeling the effects of the unrest.

The main thing most affected is the rising price of food. Most Haitian families try to eat one cooked meal a day. The heart of that meal is usually beans and rice. Right now, the increase in the price of food is making that difficult.

One way you can help families survive this difficult time is to give for special food distributions. It costs about \$4,000 to provide beans and rice to the families at one of our schools. Our desire is to distribute food at all 13 schools and 2 vocational schools where we serve. Giving food like this will help families immediately and be a tremendous encouragement to them.

Another way you can help is to give your sponsored child a gift of rice and beans for their family. Pictured to the left is a girl who recently received rice and beans from her sponsor. Can you imagine the expression on her mother's face when she got home and showed her mom what she got from her sponsor! A family package of food cost \$25 and can be given from our website.

We have had children and family members saved in the schools and churches and even through the clinic. One of the most requested gifts is a Bible. One of our supporters recently gave \$300 to buy Bibles. He challenged someone else to do the same. Your support will have an eternal effect on the lives of the Haitian people. Thank you.


