## How Your Offerings Were Used In 2019

We are truly grateful for the resources that you entrusted to us in 2019. Because of that, we would like to share with you how your offerings were used throughout the ministry last year.

The heart of Mission To Haiti is Child Sponsorship. It is the hub in which all of the other ministries are connected. Sponsorship payments provide for key areas of support: Christian education, vocational training, meals at school and healthcare through our campus clinic.

Beyond that, Sponsorship is the springboard for reaching people outside of the schools. When a child is sponsored, they immediately become connected with a local Bible-believing church. This structure provides the means to organize food distributions, bring mission teams, dig wells and more. Most importantly, it lays the foundation to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to children and families.

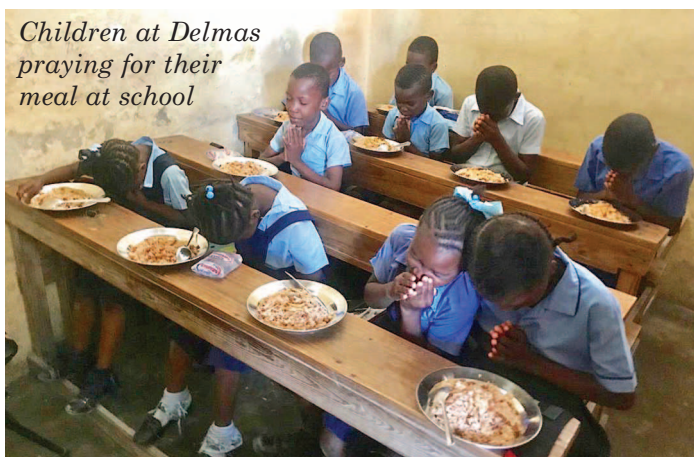
