During this time of COVID-19, our people in Haiti have seen the evidence of God's providential work in their lives. In the midst of great distress, God reminded Jeremiah, *"For I know the plans that I have for you, declares the Lord,... to give you a future and a hope."* The Lord has a future and a hope for the people of Haiti too.

Let us tell you about Adline Joseph. She is married with two children. She and her husband are believers. Several years ago, Adline found herself in a distressing situation. She had no job and no way to contribute to the family's income. It put stress on her relationships and eventually her marriage. As Adline describes, she and her husband became so discouraged that they stopped going to church. Adline did not know that God was already at work in the midst of her distress. He was preparing to give her a future and a hope that would bless her during COVID-19 and beyond.

Soon after, she visited the Vocational School and met Pastor and Mme. Cadet. Adline enrolled in their three-year sewing program. She got involved in the Bible studies that Pastor Cadet led. She was mentored by Mme. Cadet and strengthened in her faith.

Last summer, Adline graduated with great pride in her accomplishment. We attended her graduation. Today, Adline works from home specializing in children's clothes. She makes dress clothes and school uniforms. She let us know how glad she is that she can earn a living and help provide for her family.

Her whole family is back in church serving the Lord. Pastor Cadet told us that she is now an intern professor. She wants to teach others how to sew so she can give back to others.

Ti Goave is one of our largest schools. Our crew brought the food from the mission campus. When they arrived several hours later, the children were waiting for them. Our local DeliMart gave them the plastic bags they needed to package the food. The event was well organized and blessed many.

We would like to continue holding these special distributions for the children at our schools who do not have a sponsor. It costs \$2,000 per school to provide food for these families. We have 5 schools still waiting to receive their special gifts of food.
