When the COVID-19 lockdowns began, we quickly switched gears. With the help of our Haitian Partners, we focused our attention on helping sponsored children and families get through this unprecedented situation.

Your regular and special offerings made the difference! We used the money for school meals to buy food for the sponsored families. We used special offerings to buy food for all the families, distribute hand washing buckets, and repair roofs ruined by a storm. By late summer, the children returned to school and we began distributing school books to the sponsored children.
