

Our Founders' Challenge 2021





This past Christmas Junior in Haiti wanted to do something special for Bill Sr. and Ann. He contacted a well known artist and commissioned the painting shown above. The entire piece is done in metal. Wilky, the artist, did similar pieces for several Haitian presidents. We brought it from Haiti and hung it in their home in Hialeah.

Below their portrait it reads, "Beloved Founder of MTH." In 1981, Bill Sr. and Ann launched Mission To Haiti with the calling from the Lord to bring the Gospel to the Haitian people. Forty years later, the ministry is reaching hundreds of people with Christian education, vocational training and help of all kinds in order to lead people to Christ.

Recently, Pino had the opportunity to speak to a group of children from our local neighborhood. Our staff has been inviting children into the mission campus to teach them Bible songs and Scripture verses. Pino shared the Gospel with a group of forty children. Five children accepted Christ.

Peterson and Jean told us how busy they have been drilling wells. In March they were drilling wells for the Red Cross in Haiti. The importance of clean, plentiful water cannot be overstated. We will email you updates as the work progresses.

Last month, we gave Pastor Michel Pierre the \$1,000 we received to plaster the inside of the church at Guedon. He still needs \$2,800 to finish the work. Thank you for your offerings.
