Our three-acre mission campus is our main headquarters in Haiti. It is divided into two sections. We have two caretakers and their families who live and work there. We also have another ten people who work from our sponsorship office and medical clinic. It is the central meeting place for our pastors, school principals and sponsored children. It is a safe and secure place to be.

When our US staff make their regular trips, we stay for a week or more. The campus is an active place and so important to the growth of the ministry. Recently, we spent \$3,000 replacing two water pumps.

It costs \$7,500 a month to keep the mission campus open and running properly. We need your regular and special offerings. Please give for our Founders' Challenge.

Cazeau School Needs New Preschool Furniture

Recently, Peterson who is the principal at the Cazeau school approached us about the condition of the furniture in the preschool classrooms. The chairs and tables in Preschool 1, 2 and 3 have simply worn out.

In December, Peterson asked for help to replace the desks in the high school classes. He had a local tradesman build

desks with metal frames and wooden seats. Those turned out real well as we reported in January.

The Cazeau pre-school classes need 60 chairs and 3 tables made from the same materials they used on the high school desks. The cost to build them will be \$1,200.
