The end of the year is quickly approaching. We are working steadily to finish 2021 with all of our ministry accounts balanced.

As we prepared this newsletter, we went through our pictures showing what was accomplished since January. It was amazing to see the work that was achieved on the mission field because of your prayers and faithful support.

Since January, we helped to build 5 homes. We dug or repaired 5 wells. Our Vocational schools graduated 19 students. Hundreds of children were educated. They ate school meals and were cared for by our clinic. Food was given to 2000 families, and dozens of children got saved through the churches, schools and Bible club. And that's not all that was done.

Our Ministry Budget is divided into 3 areas: Operating Budget, Founders' Challenge and Sponsorship. These are the accounts we use to fund our ongoing ministries and to support our special projects. Everyone in Haiti depends on this support. We are careful to give it timely and consisently so the work can continue.

Your support this year has been great. Because of the difficulty that Haiti is experiencing, we have been called on to do more. We want to expand our reach in Haiti, but we need your prayers and support.
