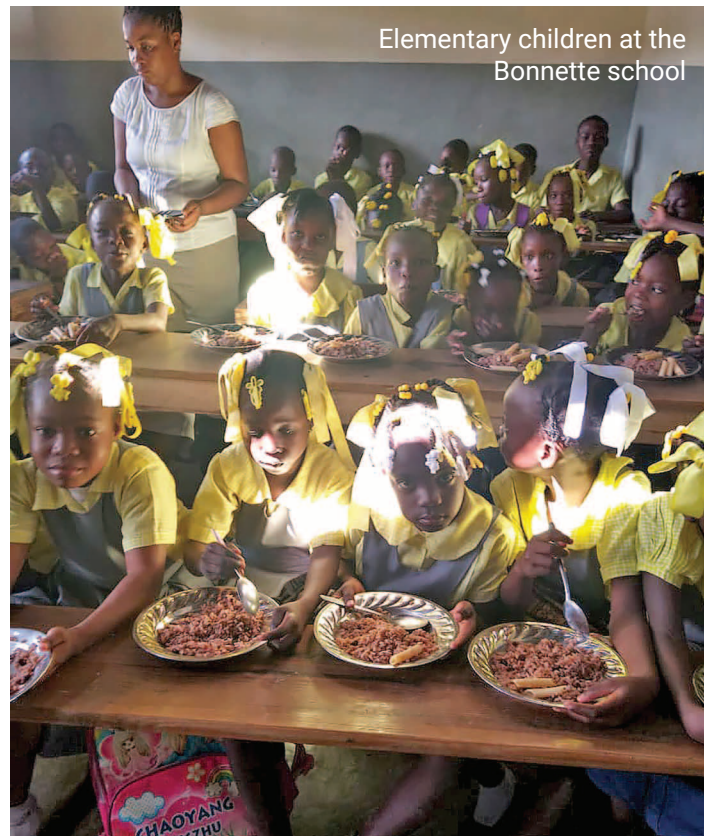
In many ways, 2021 was a difficult year. In other ways, it proved to be a very good year. The pandemic caused more families to turn to the churches and schools for help for things they cannot provide themselves. This has caused Mission To Haiti to expand its capacity for ministry. Needs turned into new opportunities for ministry. Reaching new children brought more children to salvation in Jesus Christ.

Two years ago our campus caretaker and his family felt led to begin afternoon Bible clubs for the neighborhood children. Schools had temporarily closed and the children were drawn to the Bible stories, singing and fellowship. Since then the Bible clubs have grown with new children. Mackenson recently said that in 2021, forty children accepted Christ at these Bible clubs.

Expanding the school meals has the capacity to draw many new children and young people into the schools. It is an effective way to address the pressing need of hunger. It introduces new children and families to the churches. It provides the means for growth in a manageable way.

Right now, the schools are receiving \$1,500 a month in additional food money. The schools are ready to receive more. Increasing the expanded school meals to \$2,000 a month will allow the schools to grow and do even more.
