In the fall of 2008, Magdala Pierre was sponsored by Leah. She came to Haiti that summer on a mission team and they both connected. Magdala's father had become the caretaker for the Cazeau school. A house was provided for the family, so it became the perfect opportunity for Magdala and her siblings to be sponsored.

After several years, Magdala's father left that position and moved the family to another part of town. Because of the move, Magdala and her siblings were not able to continue at Cazeau or in the Sponsorship Program. However, Leah stayed in contact with Magdala. The family struggled financially so Leah sent help from time to time. Difficulty took its toll on the family but Leah continued to help.

In the fall of 2018, Magdala reached out to Leah to tell her she had AIDS. In Haiti, this diagnosis is a curse. Family and friends can shun you. But through Leah's prayers and support, Magdala was able to locate a facility that provided the meds she needed to manage her health.

Recently, Magdala expressed a desire to settle down and pursue a career. As the Lord would have it, she is living close to the Vocational school. Magdala registered and is now a part of the sewing program. Magdala commented how kind everyone has been to her.

Pastor and Madam Cadet are ready to minister to her spiritual needs as well. By God's grace, Magdala has been given a fresh start. We are praying that God will do a great work in her life.
