Work has begun on Marie Joe's new home. With the funds you gave so far, the workmen have poured the headers and roof. Work has stopped until more funds are available.

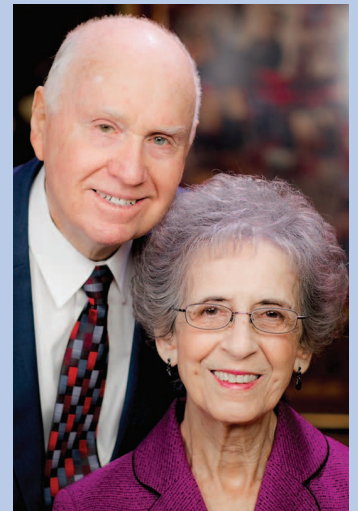
