



The Result Of Sponsoring A Child

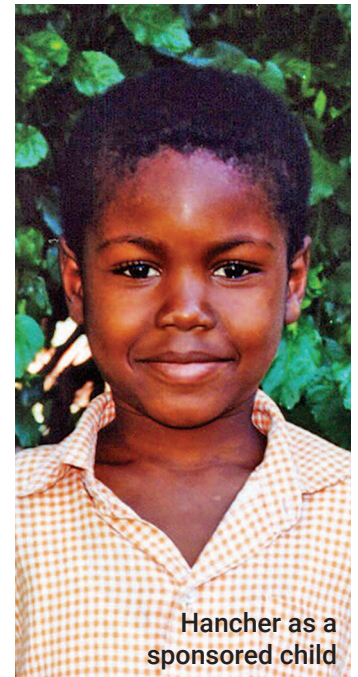
In January of 2002, Hancher Duval was sponsored by John and Lena. He was seven years old. He was selected as a replacement child because John and Lena's previous child left the Cazeau school. This opened the door for Hancher to be sponsored and secure his education. Only the Lord knew what was in store for Hancher and Mission To Haiti.

As a sponsored child, Hancher was saved through the ministry of the Cazeau church and later baptized. He served as a youth leader and eventually became a Sunday School teacher. As his faith grew, so did his opportunity to learn. Hancher went to college to study law. He was seeking God's will, not knowing where that would lead.

It was during this time that Hancher connected with Mission To Haiti. Hancher's cousin Junior was serving with us already. The sponsorship crew was short handed so Hancher began helping out. In November 2014 Mission To Haiti hired Hancher to serve full-time. He became a dedicated Haitian Partner.

We refer to the staff members in Haiti as Partners. That's because we all work side by side in this ministry. It's also because our Partners have an equal stake in the outcome.

Now more than eight years later, Hancher is a great asset to this ministry. He says, "I learned from leaders that God should be the center of our lives, and that

In April, Hancher arrived in South Florida. Because of the current circumstances in Haiti, he was given the opportunity to come to the States. It was not something any of us planned, but we believe it is something God can use to benefit Hancher and Mission To Haiti.

The plan is for Hancher to work with Mission To Haiti from Miami for the present time. He has already begun working with Bill Jr. and Chelsea with sponsorship and other Stateside projects. We are realizing the benefit of his presence here. Certain updates and translation work that could only be done in Haiti is now possible from the Miami office. While Hancher works with us, he will work on his status to travel between Haiti and the U.S.

For the present time, Hancher is staying with Bill Jr. and Sherril as well as with Haitian families in the area. In the coming months, Hancher will need an apartment, a car, insurance and a salary to support these things.

From what we can determine, Hancher will need \$28,000 for 2023.

These funds are not in our present budget, so they will need to be raised accordingly. We believe that Hancher can be an asset to Mission To Haiti for years to come. Please keep this in your prayers.
