## Summer Bible Schools Need Your Support

For us here at home, we remember how Vacation Bible School had an impact on our childhood. One of Mission To Haiti's earliest ministries was VBS for children. Since then, many children have been saved through the Bible schools. One of our Haitian pastors recalls how he was saved at a Bible school held under a mango tree. In a country where voodoo is still pervasive, Haitian children need to hear and accept the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Last summer, MTH supported three Bible schools. They included Bible stories, art projects, games and a daily meal for all the children. The meal alone draws many hungry children. Recently, one of our sponsored children said they would come to school seven days a week just to receive the school meal. Meals open the door for children to come and hear

the Gospel. Last summer over a dozen children accepted Christ.

**A one-week Bible school will cost \$1,000.** This covers preparing the space, buying the needed materials and providing a daily meal.

This summer, we would like to support 5 Bible schools. This will represent 1,000 children from the schools and neighborhoods who need to hear the Gospel.

**Altogether these Bible schools will need \$5,000.**

Our ministry leaders are ready. The children are ready. They need your prayers and financial support.
