February Crusade At The Mission Campus





We had the opportunity to meet Steve Pettit at a Christian school conference last fall. He had recently launched a new ministry, Steve Pettit Ministries. He and his group are an evangelistic team who use Bluegrass music to preach the gospel. Although Bluegrass is not common in Haiti, the culture has a history of traditional music played on hand-made instruments. Bluegrass is a style of music Haitians can appreciate.

We invited Steve and his team to hold a crusade at the mission campus and they accepted. We set dates for the beginning of February. The plan is to hold four evening meetings and two days of Bible school for children. Pastor Jimmy from the Cazeau church is coordinating with the other pastors in our area to provide support from their local churches and promote this special evangelistic event.

This crusade is a great way for Mission To Haiti to launch the new year. Hundreds of new families and thousands of new people are relocating to the area around the mission campus. Many of them have no connection with a local church, so an event like this has the potential to draw many people. We are expecting hundreds of children and family members to show up.
