Help Teachers To Do Their Best Work



There are more than 100 teachers, administrators and staff members who serve at Mission To Haiti's sponsored schools. These educators work faithfully under difficult conditions to provide the best education they can give the sponsored children. The children and families depend on the teachers being ready and available. Sometimes they are not able to do their best work because of the lack of funds.

On average a teacher or staff member earns \$125 a month in salary. They are paid through the tuition payments of the students. Tuition for the sponsored children is covered by the sponsorship payments. Mission To Haiti faithfully gives the schools these funds each month. However, there are many children who attend the sponsored schools who are not sponsored. Often these non-sponsored families are slow to pay their child's tuition payments for lack of funds. Sometimes these families are unable to pay anything. The schools will keep these children enrolled as long as possible. But the lack of tuition money can prevent the schools from paying their teachers and staff members fully. At the same time, the cost of living for a family in Haiti continues to rise each year.



One solution is to sponsor more children. Mission To Haiti works continually to enlist new sponsors. Throughout the year, we go to conferences and visit churches to promote sponsorship. Your faithful sponsorship payments help greatly. However, our sponsored schools need a boost of support. Special support for teachers' salaries is another solution.

Monthly gifts of \$125 would be given to the schools to boost their monthly income. This surge of support would help teachers and staff members directly at a time when they are having trouble making ends meet.
