School Begins In Haiti On October 1st





The Ganthier School Needs To Relocate

Ganthier is a rural town near the boarder with the Dominican Republic. We have been serving there for more than 20 years. Earlier this year, the gang which is led by the infamous Lanmò Sanjou overwhelmed the city. They forced all the people to leave. Among those who left are the families of our sponsored children.

Since then, we have been supporting these sponsored children to attend schools in safer areas. They were hoping to move back to Ganthier by now. However, the town is still not safe to return. At the same time, Gesner, the Ganthier principal, does not want to close the school. He has offered another solution.

Gesner and his teachers would like to set up classes in a nearby location temporarily. There is a neighboring town which is safe and quiet. By resuming classes in this setting, the school can keep the children connected to them and Mission To Haiti. Then when it is safe again, they will return to Ganthier.

Gesner detailed the things they will need: children's desks, teachers' desks, chalkboards and classroom materials. All these are things they can bring back to Ganthier.

The cost to make the furniture and buy the materials is \$5,500. Your offerings will be greatly appreciated. It will allow us to keep helping Ganthier.

Summer Camps And VBS Are Changing Lives



As the summer camps are winding down at the Vocational School and Beudet, the Vacation Bible Schools are ramping up. There are 6 Bible Schools that are underway, including the VBS at the mission campus. They had 600 children show up the first day. Thankfully they were able to use the tables and chairs from the new preschool for the craft projects and meals.

There is one more VBS that needs funding. It is the one at Bonnette. The cost will be \$1,000. If you can give, your gift will help change lives. We are praying for many to be saved at these Bible Schools.
