Her father and two older brothers were murdered by gang members. The gang killed them, then burned their bodies and then their house. Abigaelle and her family lost everything.

Abigaelle, her mom and baby sister ran for their lives. Eventually they ended up in our community living with

a family friend. By that time, the baby sister was malnourished and suffering with a high fever. Abigaelle's mom felt overwhelmed. She asked her good friend to take care of Abigaelle until she could get back on her feet. One of the first things the family friend did was to enroll Abigaelle in the Mission To Haiti Academy. In no time, Abigaelle's sadness turned to hope. She's eating good meals and learning in a nurturing environment.

No Child Should Learn On An Empty Stomach – You Can Change That



Two years ago, we told you the story of a boy who shared his school lunch with his mother. The boy is Gamael, pictured above. His mother was at home with nothing to eat. So he wrapped up half his lunch and brought it home to her. When we heard the story we were stunned. We knew the importance of the school meals to the children, but we were amazed to realize how significant these meals are to the family members who are at home.

When the school year started in October we evaluated the cost to provide hot meals to all the children who we serve. Right now, Mission To Haiti partners with 14 Christian schools. There are 2500 students who attend these schools, and there are 250 faculty and staff members there. We determined that it costs \$1 to buy, cook and deliver a hot, hearty school meal to each child and staff.

Most of the children do not eat anything for breakfast. Most of these children are not sponsored. Yet, we feel an obligation to help those who are under our care to eat. They have no one else.

In addition to the support that sponsors provide, the schools will need an additional \$100,000 to provide meals this academic year. Prayerfully consider adding to your monthly support for these school meals.
