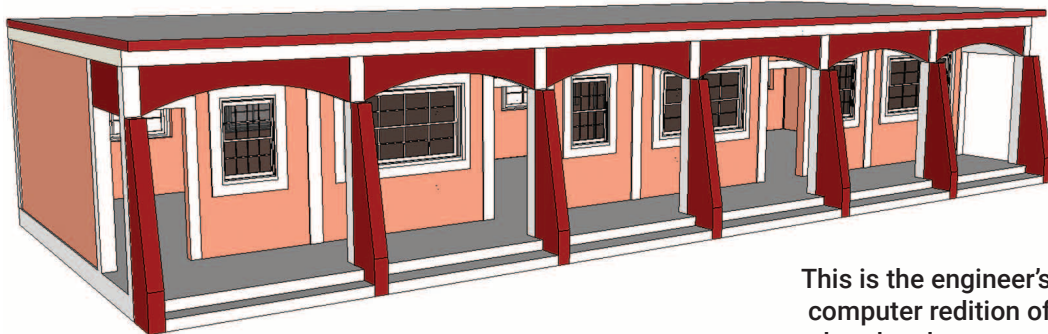

The new school will be built on the mission campus, opposite the preschool. It will be in an ideal position for future growth.

Plans are to have these facilities ready for the start of school in September. Our work crew is ready to begin. They only need the funds to start.

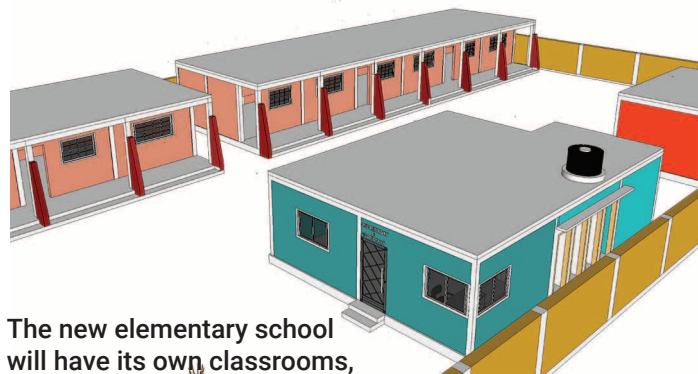
**We need your support to build this new school. Thank you for giving to this work.**

**P**ictured here are the engineer's drawings for the new elementary school. First through third grades will be in building one. Fourth through sixth grades will be in building two next door. The classroom buildings will be reinforced to accommodate a second floor when that time is needed. In the same courtyard will be the administrative offices, storage facilities and the bathrooms. The kitchen will occupy its own separate facility where the school meals will be prepared. This new elementary school will accommodate 240 students.

The new elementary school is phase two of the Mission To Haiti Academy. The vision is to give Haitian children and young people an excellent Christian education. By equipping them with the Gospel and quality training, they will have the means to change Haiti for Christ.

This vision is already seeing fruit. The new preschool has only been open for a few months, but it is now recognized as one of the best schools in our area. The program is excellent. The children are learning and eating good meals. Your prayers and support are producing results.

Eventually we would like to build a high school, a vocational school and a school of ministry to train young people for full-time service. Imagine if all our current churches and schools operated at this same degree. It would truly be amazing. With God nothing is impossible.
