In January, Bill Jr. went to Haiti to begin the construction on the new elementary school. Thank you for your quick response to give. Marckendy our engineer is directing the project. He started with the classroom footings and columns. The footings are deep enough to accommodate a second floor in the

future. All the work is being done by hand by local tradesmen. The workmen start early in the morning and finish well after 5pm. They're doing a great job.

As the footings are completed, the workmen form up and pour the columns. There are 50 columns in the layout of the classrooms. The steel rebar is being assembled by
