

\$50,000 Needed To Continue Building



The foundation of the classrooms is ready for the walls

Our engineer told us that he needs \$50,000 right now to start the next phase of the work.

We are planning to have 250 students in the new elementary school. It will cost \$1,000 per student to build this brand new school and facility. Please consider giving \$1,000 to provide a place for a child. Thank you for giving!

Within in a few months, the new Mission To Haiti Academy Elementary School has begun to take shape. The footings for the six classrooms are in and the blocks are ready to be laid into place. The builders have also built the septic tanks for the new bathrooms. The floor for the bathrooms is ready to be poured. When the classroom walls are up the columns will be poured.

Since January, \$80,000 has been used to reach this point in the construction. The total cost of the new elementary school will be \$250,000. That means \$170,000 is still needed in Haiti to finish the new school and have everything ready for September.

As we prepare this newsletter, a generous gift of \$10,000 has been given. The offerings you are giving are wonderful, but more support is needed.
