## \$10,000 Needed To Complete Phase 2



Phase 1 completed the foundation and walls of the classrooms. Phase 2 will pour the ceilings and begin the kitchen and bathrooms.

Almost half of all the money has been raised so far, praise the Lord! Another \$130,000 will be needed to complete everything in time for September. The new elementary school is the talk of the town. The new preschool has become the best school in our area. We believe the elementary school will be as well.

Last month when we reported on the new elementary school, the construction was at ground level. Today, the classroom walls are up and the tie beam on the top of the walls has been done. The classrooms are ready for the ceiling to be poured. This will serve as the top of the classrooms and also as the floor for the second story. In time, the second floor will house the middle school the high school.

Thank you for your response to last month's newsletter. Mission To Haiti is supported by churches and families. We serve churches, church schools and families in Haiti. We are trusting the Lord that every need will be met.

**Another \$10,000 is needed now in order for the builders to take the next step. With that, they will pour the classroom ceilings and begin work on the bathrooms and kitchen.**

## Urgent Need For Meals And Surgeries

Mission To Haiti is approached often by families to help in times of great personal need. As the number of sponsored children grows, so do the needs we are asked to help. Families come to us when they have exhausted their own resources and have nowhere else to turn. We view these situations as ministries opportunities.

Right now, there are several children and parents who are either in the hospital or they are waiting to have surgery. **The cost to cover these hospital stays and surgeries is \$3,500.** The sponsors are helping, but the cost is more than they can cover completely. Your help with these medical expenses are greatly appreciated.

It cost \$1 to give a child a healthy, nutritious school meal. For poor children who are not eating well at home, a hearty school meal is a great reason to come to class.

Your sponsorship payments help greatly to provide school meals, but they are not enough to feed every child in our schools. An additional \$135,000 is needed this year to feed all of our school children well. It sounds like a lot but with your help every need will be met. Thank you.
